

HOW TO CREATE MY VIDEO FOR WRO 2020-X

General

- All team members have to show up on the video but no coach or parent
- ➤ Videos shall be made in Landscape mode (16:9)
- > Hold the phone camera still or use a tripod for image stability
- > Do a sound check to make sure we can hear you
- > Do a visual check to make sure your lighting is good
- > Do not increase or lower the video speed



Open Category details

- > Do not exceed **2 minutes 30 seconds** in total, including a short presentation of your team
- > Do your Open presentation and your robotic demo
- ➤ Use any location as your booth, you can be outside or inside, be creative!
- > Add printed posters in you background or digital posters over your video
- Video editing is allowed except during the robotic demo
- > Speak with your own voice. If not in English, add subtitles in English

Regular Category details

- ➤ Do not exceed **2 minutes 30 seconds** in total, including the run and the team appearance at the beginning
- ➤ Place a timer so it is visible from the camera. Use a tablet or cell phone timer app
- ➤ Place the camera at a 45 degrees angle minimum
- > All team members shall show up at the camera and say Hi
- > Start your robot (using the Run button) and the timer at the same time. Max run time is 2 minutes.
- Videos have to be made in one sequence only. No video editing.





Surprise Category details

- ➤ Do not exceed **2 minutes 30 seconds** in total, including the run and the team appearance at the beginning
- > Place a timer so it is visible from the camera. Use a tablet or cell phone timer app.
- > All team members shall show up at the camera and say Hi
- > Start your robot (using the Run button) and the timer at the same time. Max run time is 2 minutes.
- > Videos have to be made in one sequence only. No video editing.

Checklist before publishing my video

- > All team members are visible at the beginning
- > No adult, coach, parent in the video
- > My video respects the time limit
- ➤ Image is clear and stable, sound is good if applicable
